



Irish Planning Institute Student Pleanáil Awards

The Irish Planning Institute Student Pleanáil Awards recognise outstanding essays, papers, literature reviews, theses, articles or other pieces of original research by a third level student or a group of students in an accredited Planning School that the Institute feels contributes to and advances the field of planning. The Student Awards are intended to recognise exceptional work by the student / students which make a significant contribution to issues relating to planning.

NOTE - Only entrants nominated and submitted by IPI accredited planning schools will be accepted. Closing date for submissions 5pm 28th June 2013.

Attributes that will be considered include:

- Innovation and relevance to current planning issues
- Originality of research topic
- Depth of research
- Methodology
- Referencing

Who can apply?

- Any individual or group of students in an IPI accredited Planning School
- IPI members and non-members
- Entrants must be a student as of May 2013
- Entries must be nominated by an accredited planning school

What will you win?

- The winning entry will be published in the Irish Planning Institute's Planning Journal *Pleanáil* (Autumn 2013)
- Runners-up and commended entries will be published in the new electronic student version of *Pleanáil* that will be circulated to all members and also available to view on the IPI website

Entry Requirements

The submitted work must have been completed within the past academic year (2012-2013). Nominations should be submitted in electronic format and accompanied by:

- I. A citation setting out why the nominated project is considered worthy by the Planning School (max 250 words)
- II. An abstract of no more than 250 words summarising the entry (suitable for promotional use)
- III. Name and contact details of the individual in the Planning School responsible for nominating the piece of research
